



## How to Cite UN Documents

UN documents follow *The Bluebook* citation style. See example citations below.

### **IMPORTANT: About URLs**

Many URLs for UN official documents will not work permanently.

To make a stable link, use this URL format: **<http://undocs.org/DOCUMENTSYMBOL>**

For example, the stable link to Resolution A/RES/67/97 would be **<http://undocs.org/A/RES/67/97>**
